

# Notice of Race

#### Venue and Regatta

Races will be held on the Firth of Kiel waters, off-shore the Schilksee Olympic Sailing Centre.

#### Rules

The following rules will apply as appropriate during the event:

- Rules of ISAF, latest edition
- German Sailing Association (DSV) Rules
- Class Rules as edited by the DODV (German Optimist class association)
- Sailing instruction according to the notice of race.

#### Classes

Optimist A  
Optimist B

International participants must at least bear a junior sailor's license issued by the national Sailing Association. To start in Class A eligibility to do so must be legitimated according to class and national rules. Alternatively, the race office shall accept sufficient evidence to be qualified for Class A racing.

#### Entry

**Dead line for entry: May, 26<sup>rd</sup> 2009 (Tuesday)**

#### Entry Restrictions and Groups

The organizing committee reserves the right to limit participation in Class A to **150** and in Class B to **100** boats. The participant list will be closed after 150

(100) boats have been accepted according to the date of entry. **International participants shall be accepted without restriction as long as they entry within the dead line.**

Participants in Class A must pay 5,00 € on check-in to obtain a group sign. There will be a full refund on its return after races. The group sign must be shown on the very top of the rig.

#### Advertising

Advertising is allowed according to Category C of ISAF rules.

#### Safety Equipment

In addition to class rules 4.3 and 4.5 all boats must have a paddle, a bailing-device with at least 3 l capacity and a

floatable haul (diameter at least 5 mm) of at least 8 m length which must be attached to the mast base. Personal buoyancy must be worn at all times.

#### Measurement

Measurement of equipment and inspection of safety equipment can be done. Measurement certificates must be held ready for inspection. There will be no measurement options for equipment.

#### Score-System

The Low-Point-System according to attachment A of ISAF rules shall apply. 1 race can be eliminated from the score when at least 4 races have been sailed.

#### Prices

Prices will be given to the first 20 sailors in Class A and B.

#### Protests

A protest-flag of at least 16 x 12 cm size must be shown in case of protest (WR 61.1 (a) will not apply).

#### Insurance and Liability

All participants must have sufficient insurance cover for regatta sailing and demonstrate insurance documents on check-in.

The organizing committee cannot be held responsible for any damage or

loss of equipment or for any personal injuries that may happen. It is the sailor's or its representative's sole decision to take part in the races with respect to weather conditions and personal ability.

The clause for exclusion/limitation of liability as edited by the DSV will apply. On check-in all participants and their legal guardians must accept and sign the disclaimer of liability.

## **Coach boats**

Coach boats can be slipped after payment of fee in the harbour office and have to be registered in the race office.
