43 teams participated in the two day team racing competition. The exciting final saw Thailand beat Singapore convincingly to become Team Racing World Champions. They also win a guaranteed place at the ISAF Team Racing Worlds in Ireland in August 2011.

Chris Atkins (Chief Umpire), a veteran official at our European Team Racing Championship but new to the Worlds said: "It was great to see the optimist class combining fleet racing and team racing at the same championship, more classes should consider this as everyone enjoys the team racing so much."



Going into the last race, Noppakao Poonpat could still be beaten by Ahmad Syukri Bin Abdul Azizended but in true champions style she kept control of the race and lead almost from the start. Noppakao had a bullet in the last race of the championship and became the Optimist World Champion 2010 in great style!
