NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of the National Authority will not apply.
- 1.3. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the 420, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Cadet and Optimist classes.
- 3.2. Pre-entry requirement: all participants shall show their intention to take part in the regatta until 18:00 10. June 2010. Pre-entries shall be sent by e-mail: byc@byc.hu.

4. FEES

4.1. Entry fee is for competitors born

before 1. January 1992: 6000 HUF or 24 EUR, on or after 1. January 1992: 3000 HUF or 12 EUR.

4.2. The entry fee is required to be paid at the registration.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Registration and entry:

Time and date: 17:00-20:00, 17. June 2010.

07:00-08:00, 18. June 2010.

Place: Regatta Office, Balatonfüredi Yacht Club Clubhouse 1st floor

5.2. Dates of racing:

18. June 2010. races back to back for all classes
19. June 2010. races back to back for all classes
20. June 2010. races back to back for all classes

5.3. Number of races:

There are eight races scheduled for each class with no more than three sailed on a day.

- 5.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 09:55, 18. June 2010.
- 5.5. Any race on 20. June 2010. for which a warning signal is not given by 15:00 will be abandoned and not re-sailed.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Copies of Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office during registration.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. The regatta will be at Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.
- 7.2. The racing area will be among Balatonfüred-Siófok-Zamárdi-Tihany.

8. THE COURSES

Trapezoid courses will be sailed with inner and outer loops.

9. INTERNATIONAL JURY

- 9.1. An international jury will be appointed in accordance with rule Appendix N and perform the duties listed in RRS N2.
- 9.2. Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in Rule 70.5.

10. SCORING

- 10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2. (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each class.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500.000 EUR per event or the equivalent.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
