The Aim of The Regatta:

Sailors are competing for the Hungarian National Youth Championship titles.

Number of Races Scheduled:

12 (twelve)

Race Area:

Races will be organized in the area in front of Gárdony, on triangular, trapezoidal, up-and-down courses.

Race Course

As published by the Organizing Authority on the Notice Board of the Regatta.

Protest:

Protests shall be handed in after the end of race, within half an hour (30 minutes) from the mooring of the Jury Boat in writing addressed to the Jury (through the Race Office). The protest fee is HUF 1,000 (one thousand).

Scoring:

The championship is planned to be organised in 12 races. Should the number of races organised be between 5 to 8, then 1 (one), between 9 to 12 races 2 (two) worst race results may be excluded. **The championship shall be valid with a minimum of four races.**

Prizes:

In case of at least 12 entries in a category, the first 6 competitors, in case of less entries a maximum of 3 competitors will be awarded with medals. Foreign entries shall be evaluated according to the auxiliary provisions of the 2010 Race Calendar. Rankings of 1 to 3 of the international regatta will receive honorary prizes.

Disclaimer of Liability:

Competitors participate in the championship entirely at their own risk. The organizers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained on water or on shore during the championship. Exclusively boats with third party liability insurance may enter the regatta.

Others:

The time and place of the sail measurement will be posted on the Board of Notice of the regatta. The boats entering the championship cannot deny placement of advertising and stickers of the race sponsors - as ordered by the Organizing Authority.
