2. Venue and Date

The championship will be held from Thursday, August 18 to
Sunday, August 21, 2011 on Lake Silvaplana.

3. Rules

the regatta will be governed by:

- 3.1 The „rules“ as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing RRS, ISAF.
- 3.2 The „Regulations for Swiss Championships“ of Swiss Sailing will apply.
- 3.3 The Class rules of IODA.
- 3.4 The Sailing Instructions SI (which will be available at the race office).
- 3.5 Special Protest Procedure with red protestflag (will be described in the Sailing instructions)
- 3.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the German text will prevail.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 The regatta is open to competitors of the Optimist-Class, born in 1996 or later.
- 4.2 Competitors must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.
- 4.3 Swiss competitors must be members of the Swiss Optimist Class Organization.

5. Advertising

- 5.1 Advertising is permitted as per ISAF Advertising Code 20 and its implementation rule by Swiss Sailing
- 5.2 The Organizing Authority reserves the right to provide Advertising of the Main Sponsor of the Event on the boats (ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20).

6. Entry

- 6.1 Entries shall be submitted to [WEBLINK SWISS OPTIMIST](#).
- 6.2 The copy of the measurement certificate, the proof of membership in an ISAF Club, the confirmation of the legitimacy for advertising (Swiss Boats) and the proof of third-party liability insurance shall be submitted by e-mail or post to:

7.2 Scheduled Races:

The Championship will be sailed with 10 valid races.
To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed.
On a single day no more than 4 valid races will be sailed.

8. Inspection and Measurement

- 8.1 Control Measurements will be conducted as per to the check list which will be handed out at check-in.
- 8.2 Measurement checks may be conducted at any time during the event.
- 8.3 No first-time measurements of boats, sails and equipment will be carried out.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A RRS will apply.
- 9.2 Excluding worst scores: After completing 4 to 9 valid races, the worst score will be excluded. If 10 valid races have been completed the worst 2 scores will be excluded.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 the following prizes will be awarded:
 - Championship Medals for the first 3 boats.
 - Prizes for positions 1 - 15
 - Special prizes for the best 3 female competitors
 - Special prizes for the best 3 Optimist B (born 2000 or later)
 - Souvenirs for all competitors

The Prize-giving Ceremony will be held after the last race, at the earliest on Sun-day morning 10:00h

11. Mooring and Parking

- 11.1 For every boat a suitable place ashore will be provided. Instructions of the organizing committee must be respected.
- 11.2 Carparking for Parents and Coaches will be assigned.

12. Support Boats

- 12.1 Support boats are not permitted.
Any coaching on the water is prohibited.

13. Social Events

- 13.1 All competitors are kindly invited to participate in the official Fridaynight Dinner on „Furtschellas“. Dinner-Tickets for Parents, Coaches and accompanying persons may be purchased at the Race-Office.

14. Doping

- 14.1 Doping controls may take place at any time according to the guidelines of «Antidoping Schweiz».

15. Liability and Insurance

- 15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 – Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 15.2 Competitors shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate coverage (min. 1,5 Mln CHF per event) and valid for racing.
