Pre Notice of Race

1 VENUE

1.1 SAILING THE DANUBE TOGETHER regatta will be held on the river Danube in Belgrade, Serbia.

1.2 The regatta is organized by Nautical Club of Palilula and Sailing Club Povetarac in conjunction with the Serbian Sailing Association.

1.3 The race office will be at the Nautical Club of Palilula, 11000 Belgrade, Serbia, Ada Huja bb.

2 RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 – 2012 (RRS).

2.2 Current Optimist class rules will apply.

2.3 No national prescriptions will apply.

2.4 If there is a conflict between Rules and languages the English text and Sailing Instruction will take precedence.

3 ADVERTISING

3.1 Boats should display advertising of the event sponsors at the both sides of her hull, if required by the Organizing Authority.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The regatta is open to unlimited Optimist boats.

4.2 Competitors must comply with the ISAF Eligibility Code.

4.3 Entries could be sent to the organiser on ncpalilula@gmail.com. Entries should be personally made in Race Office at Friday, June 1st, from 17:00 to 20:00 and Saturday, June 2nd, from 9:30 to 11:30.

4.4 There will be no Entry fee.

5 PROGRAMME

June 1st 9:30-20:00 Arrival and registrations.

June 2nd 9:30 do 11:30 Arrival and registrations

 10:30 Opening ceremony

 12:00 Start of 1st Race first day

June 3rd According to Sailing Instructions, start of 1st Race second day

 Prize giving ceremony

5.1 There will be no more than four races per day.

6 EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECK

6.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the rules.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available to each competitor at registration.

8 COURSES

8.1 Race area will be on the river Danube near the Pancevo Bridge in Belgrade, in front of NC Palilula.

8.2 The courses to be sailed will be posted in Sailing Instruction.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 Appendix P RRS will apply.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

10.2 The regatta shall consist of up to 6 races.

10.3 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

10.4 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.5 Scores for categories Girls and Cadets (under 12) will be taken from overall results unchanged.

10.6 Final individual scores of best four competitors from Cities of Bratislava, Wien, Budapest and Belgrade, taken from overall results unchanged, will be aggregated in scoring for the FOUR CITIES CUP 2012.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Participants compete entirely at their own risk and responsibility. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

11.2 The Organizing Authority and any other party involved in the organization of the Cup accept no liability whatsoever for any injury, damage, death, loss or claim, whether personal or material, incurred by or inflicted to participants before, during or after the Cup.

12 TROPHIES

12.1 Prizes will be awarded to:

First three competitors overall

First three girl competitors

First three competitors under 12 years old

12.2 FOUR CITIES TROPHY will be awarded to the team with the lowest total points.

13 MEDIA RIGHTS

13.1 All competitors, owners of boats and their guests give to organizing authorities all rights for photos, videos of persons and boats before, during and after regatta in media inclusive publicity & press materials for all Organizers activity.
