**NOTICE OF RACE**

**Introduction**

Dear Sailors and colleagues, Under the umbrella of the Egyptian Sailing & Water Ski Federation (ESWF), Yacht Club of Egypt at Alexandria is organizing a **Sailing Forum**, just before the Arab championship, As a preparation for the **ARAB Championship** giving you the opportunity to train together & to perform series of races before the main event.

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The Forum will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017-2020 & Class Rules.
- 1.2 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The Equipment Rules of Sailing and current class rules of competing classes will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**2 Classes**

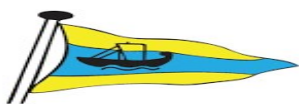
- 2.1 Following Classes: Laser **Standard**, Laser **Radial**, Laser **4.7** (Born 2002 or Later) & **Optimist** (Born 2004 or Later)

**3 ADVERTISING**

- 3.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and/or advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

**4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats & to competitors who comply with **WORLD SAILING Regulation 19 – Eligibility**.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form page of the Forum: not later than 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2019
- 4.3 In addition to the requirements of 4.3 Competitors, Team leaders, Coaches shall deliver signed entry forms & register no later than the **15<sup>th</sup> of August 2019** by e-mail & at the **Race Office** no later than **09:00 on 16<sup>th</sup> of October 2019** .
- 4.4 Travel details should be sent to the organizing e-mail ([yce.sailing.org@hotmail.com](mailto:yce.sailing.org@hotmail.com)) **one week before arrival date otherwise we won't be able to manage for you Airport Transportation**.



## **5 FEES**

5.1 Regatta Entry Fees for Officials, Coaches and Sailors will be **350 U\$ Dollars**; which covers the **Daily Nutrition, Coach Boat, Charter Boat, Accommodation, 1\* Free Egyptian Telecom with Data & Internal Transportation.**

5.2 Registration Fees: **No Registration Fees are Required.**

5.3 Damage deposit, Refundable damage deposit of **100 U\$ per sailor** will be collected during the registration.

## **6 Forum Format**

6.1 The Forum will consist of a single series with 12 races for each class.

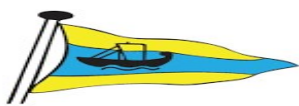

### **11 THE COURSES**

11.1 The diagrams in **Attachments # 1** show the course types, including the order in which marks are to be passed.

### **12 PENALTY SYSTEM**

12.1 Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.

12.2 RRS P2.3 will not apply and RRS P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

12.3 Decisions of the [protest committee] [international jury] will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

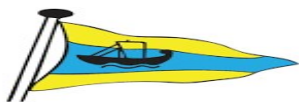
### **13 SCORING**

13.1 The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply.

13.2 12 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.3 (a) When 4 races have been completed, the regatta will be valid and a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst race score.



- (c) When more than 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst 2 races score.

#### **14 SUPPORT BOATS**

- 14.1 Support boats shall be marked with national flag. [DP]

#### **15 BERTHING**

- 15.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the [boat park] [harbor]. [DP]

#### **16 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 16.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

#### **17 PRIZES**

- 17.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
- The first 3 overall places in each class.
  - The first 3 places for girl's in each class.
  - The first 3 places for juniors (Born 2008 or Later) optimist class.

#### **18 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY**

- 18.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### **19 INSURANCE**

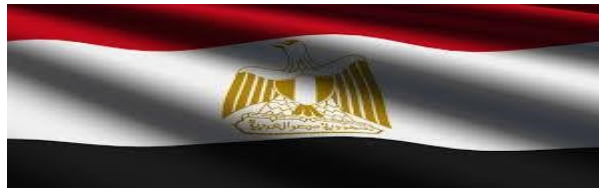
- 19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 100\$ per incident or the equivalent.

- 20.1 All laser sailors must bring all their equipment including (**Deck cleats+ Deck Blocks and Plate , tailor and extension, sails and patterns**)

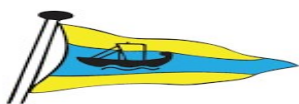
