OptiGirls can also choose to win an Optimist World Championship if they want to, just like **Elisa Yokoyama**, from Singapore in 2012, **Kimberley Lim** from Singapore in 2011, and **Noppakao Poonpat**, from THA in 2010.

OptiGirls can also go on and choose to become Olympic Champions if they want to, just like: Marit Bouwmeester from the Netherlands, 2016 Gold Medalist in the Radial; Hanna Mills and her crew Saskia Clark from the United Kingdom, 2016 Gold Medalists in the 470; and Martine Soffiata Grael and her crew Kahena Kunze from Brasil, 2016 Gold Medalists in the 49erFX; andLijia Xu, from China, 2012 Gold Medalist in the Radial Class to name just a few.

OptiGirls can also choose to go on to win the 2017-18 Ocean Race if they want to just like **Carolijn Brouwer** from the Netherlands and **Marie Riou** from France.

OptiGirls can also choose to become the female World Sailor of the year if they want to just like **Ann-Marie Rindom**, from Denmark who was awarded it in 2019, alongside Marco Gradoni from Italy, 3-time Optimist World Champion.

All of the sailors mentioned above were OptiGirls. Whatever Challenge an OptiGirl chooses, she can face it head on because **OptiGirls are resilient**, strong and fearless!

Let's celebrate all the OptiGirls and their achievements on International Women's Day and let's **#ChoosetoChallenge!**



At the 2020 AGM, the **Articles 16 and 17 were amended** so that Members have more time to consider any Article, Championship Condition and/or Class Rule Change and make a proposal to the AGM for consideration and approval if possible.

The revised date for submitting a proposal is now set 90 days prior the AGM. The 2021 AGM will be taking place in Riva del Garda, Italy on Wednesday, July 7th, which means that the **deadline to** submit a proposal to IODA is Friday, April 8th.

The amended Articles also changed when the AGM Agenda and Proposals are to be sent out to the Members. The deadline for doing so is 60 days prior to the AGM or Saturday, May 8th.

The AGM is the highest authority of IODA and is formed by the official representatives of Members present or their substitutes. The future direction of the Optimist Class is decided by the Members.

The Optimist Class is coming up to its 60th Anniversary as an International Class and throughout its history, it has been the active participation and input of our Members who have shaped the class over the years.

If you want to see a change in any part of the Optimist Class from how it is managed, to a change in a championship, or in the boat itself, then take this opportunity to submit a proposal that can be presented to the Members at the AGM.

Be reminded as per Article 3 (b) (iii) that only fully paid up Members can make proposals at the Annual General Meeting. That means that only Members can make proposals and not individuals and that Members are required to pay your 2021 IODA Subscription Dues.

2021 NAMS



The 2021 Optimist North American Championship (NAMS) will be taking place in Riviera Nayarit, Mexico, May 29 to June 5th.

The Event organizer is intensely preparing and looking forward to welcoming the sailors to Riviera Nayarit at the end of May.

113 sailors from 12 countries have registered for the event - ARG, BAH, BER, BRA, CAY, CHI, GUA, MEX, PUR, USA, URU and ISV. Large teams will be coming from USA (24), MEX(16), ARG (15), BRA (15), BAH (13) and BER (10).

BAH has seen an upsurge in Optimist activity since hosting the last NAMS in Nassau in 2019. Hosting an IODA Continental Championship can completely reinvigorate your Optimist program. The legacy for BAH is that they will be one of the largest teams at the NAMS in 2021.

In addition, the IODA Technical Committee is planning on holding a Measurement Seminar for Members from North America on May 27 to 29th. Topics covered will be full measurement of sails, spars and foils, how to carry out inspections on the water, plus a discussion of Class Rules and the aspect of One-Design.

2021 European Championship

The 2021 Optimist European Championship will be taking place in El Puerto Santa Maria, ESP from June 20 to 27th.



The deadline for the Second Entry Stage deadline is fast approaching on March 30th.



Late penalty surcharges will apply.

Although we were able to host the Europeans in 2020, we are committed to hosting the European Championships in 2021.

To date 229 sailors from 36 countries have registered - ARG, AUT, BEL, BRA, BUL, CRO, CYP, CZE, DEN, EST, FIN, FRA,

2021 World Championship



The 2021 Optimist World Championship will be taking place in Riva del Garda, ITA from June 30th to July 10th.

The Second Entry Stage Deadline is April 15th. Late penalty surcharges will apply.

IODA is committed to hosting the World Championships in 2021 as we were unable to do so in 2020 due to the pandemic. We continue to monitor the situation very closely while working with the Organizing Committee in the planning of the event.

To date, 245 sailors have registered from 53 countries: ANT, ARG, AUT, AZE, BAH, BLR, BEL, BER, BRA, BUL, CAY, CHI, COL, CRO, CYP, CZE, DEN, ESP, EST, FIN, FRA, GER, GBR, GRE, HUN, IRL, ISR, ITA, JPN, LAT, LTU, MLT, MEX, NED, NOR, PER, POL, POR, PUR, ROU, RSA, RUS, SRB, SVK, SLO, SWE, SUI, THA, TUR, UKR, USA, URU and ISV.
