

# NOTICE OF RACE

## Coupe Internationale d'Eté OPTIMIST

### Centre Nautique de Plérin

From Saturday 17 to Friday 23 August 2019

*The notation "[DP]" in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the jury, be less than disqualification.*

#### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by :

- 1.1. The rules as defined in 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. National prescriptions applying to foreign competitors specified in the Appendix "Prescriptions".
- 1.3. Federal regulations.
- 1.4. In case of translation of this notice of race, the French text will take precedence.

#### 2. ADVERTISING [DP]

Boats shall display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 3.1. The regatta is open to:
  - All boats that comply with the rules of the Optimist class measurement.
  - All currents born from 2004.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online form on the website: [www.cie2019-2020.com](http://www.cie2019-2020.com)

**The form will be available from february 5th.**

- 3.3. Sailors with a FFVoile license must be able to present at the time of registration:
  - The membership to Promotion Optimist 2019, which certifies the deposit on the POP site of the following documents:
    - ✓ Parental authorization POP 2019 (model on the POP website: [http://promotion-optimist.fr/docs/Autorisation\\_parentale\\_POP\\_2019.pdf](http://promotion-optimist.fr/docs/Autorisation_parentale_POP_2019.pdf) )
    - ✓ Pages 1 and 2 of the IODA booklet corresponding to the boat declared on the event (concordance between sailor and owner of the boat).
    - ✓ The 2019 "Competition" type license.
    - ✓ If necessary, the authorization for advertising.
- 3.4. Foreign sailors without a FFVoile license must present at the time of registration:
  - ✓ Proof of membership of a National Authority member of World Sailing.
  - ✓ Valid proof of insurance in civil liability with a minimum cover of two million Euros.
  - ✓ A medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of sailing in competition dating less than a year (written in French or in English).
  - ✓ Parental authorization.

#### 4. CATEGORIES

- Minims / Cadets: sailors born in 2007, 2006, 2005 and 2004.
- Benjamins: sailors born in 2009 and 2008.
- Open / criterium: beginner's sailors.
- Unless expressly requested, foreign runners born in 2008, 2009 and later will be registered in the qualified Benjamin group.



## 5. FEES

5.1. Required fees are as follows:

- 90€ until 4th August 2019.
- As of August 5th, 2019, registrations will be increased to 110€.

5.2. From the third child of the same family, the registration of the third and subsequent children is reduced by 50% (valid on the base rate).

5.3. Conditions of repayment:

- In case of withdrawal, the sailors will be reimbursed only in case of force majeure, after decision of the Organizing Authority who may require a medical certificate.

## 6. QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

6.1. If there are more than 80 sailors in a category, the regatta may be turned into qualifying and final series.

- The qualifying series will last 3 days, subject to shuffling, and if at least 4 races have been completed for all groups.

6.2. The distribution of the first day will be based on the national ranking published 48 hours before the first day of the event.

Foreign sailors will be randomly distributed.

6.3. All Minims groups will run the qualifying series on the same round.

6.4. For the final phase, the last Minims group might sail on the round of Benjamins.

## 7. SCHEDULE

7.1. Confirmation of registration:

- ✓ Saturday, August 17 from 9:00 to 13:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00.
- ✓ Sunday, August 18 from 9:00 to 17:00.
- ✓ Sunday, August 18 from 10:00 to 13:00; Registration team race.

7.2. Coaches Meeting at 10:00 am Sunday, August 18th.

7.3. Dates of Racing, date and time of the 1st warning signal:

The Team Race program will be specified on site.

7.4. On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 3.30pm.

7.5. The price giving ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the races on Friday, August 23<sup>th</sup>.



## 8. MEASUREMENT

8.1. At registration, each sailor shall produce:

- **The paper version**, completed, of its declaration of measurement (models available on the site of the POP, <http://promotion-optimist.fr/fr/pages/Gauge/> ).
- His life jacket and whistle, in accordance with ISO 12402-5 (level 50) or its equivalent indicating the serial number and the date of manufacture.

8.2. Measurement checks may be organized throughout the event.

## 9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions and any appendix will be:

- Displayed on the official board according to the federal prescription.
- Available in electronic version, at the latest on the first day of the event, at the following address : [www.cie2019-2020.com](http://www.cie2019-2020.com)

## 10. RACING AREAS

10.1. The race area is located: see chart in appendix.

10.2. Three rounds are set up (see chart in appendix):

- Alpha Round for Open/criterium.
- Bravo Round for benjamin.
- Charlie Round for minim/Cadet.

## 11. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed are IODA trapeze type with a gate.

## 12. PENALTY SYSTEM

In the case of umpired races, RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the two-turn penalty is changed to a one-turn penalty.

## 13. SCORING

13.1. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 14. SUPPORT PERSONS [DP]

14.1. Coaches and support persons must pre-register at the following URL: <https://www.cie2019-2020.com/inscription-registrati> from February 5th.

14.2. Coaches shall provide, at the latest at the confirmation of registration, the list of sailors under their responsibility during the event.

14.3. Coaches and support boats will be moored to dead body boat in front of the nautical centre.

14.4. Some coaches and support boats may be included in the safety system at the discretion of the organizer.

## 15. RIGHT TO IMAGE

By participating in this event, each sailor or his legal representative, tacitly authorizes the organizing authority, the OPTIMIST Promotion, the sponsors of the event and the photographers or cameramen to use and broadcast, without limitation, moving photos or static, racing or ashore, films or television recordings and other reproductions of himself during and after the period of the competition entitled "CIP" to which the rider participates in his full agreement. It allows a free exploitation of the said images without any compensation for its right to the image.



## 16. . RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

Except in case of emergency, a boat that is racing shall neither make radio transmission nor receive radio communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

## 17. PRIZES

Prizes will be distributed as follows:

- To the first 3 of the scratch ranking and the first 3 girls, in Minims and in Benjamins (if they are not already rewarded)
- To the first boy and the first girl 1<sup>st</sup> year (born in 2007) if they are not already rewarded.
- To the first boy and the first girl 1<sup>st</sup> year (born in 2009) if they are not already rewarded.

## 18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The decision to race or stay in the race is their sole responsibility.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
