

## 1st INTERNATIONAL HALLOWEEN REGATTA

November 2, 3 & 4 - 2018

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta will be organized by Dinghycoach and Sailing Events Management S.L. in collaboration with Club Nautico Castillo del Aguila.

#### 1. DATE AND VENUE

The regatta will take part from 2nd November until 4th November, 2018.  
The venue will be Marina Rubicon, Playa Blanca, Lanzarote, Canary Islands, Spain.

Regatta Office will be located in Capitania square next to Reception of Marina Rubicon.

#### 2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), following International Optimist Class Rules (IODA) and Canarian Federation prescriptions.

2.2 RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply.

2.3 If there is any conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence (modifies RRS 63.7).

2.4 If there is a conflict between languages the Spanish text will take precedence.

#### 3. ADVERTISING

3.1 Sailors may be required to display advertisement when provided by the Organizing authority.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Competitors are required to be current members of the Optimist organizing authority for their country of residence. Competitors must be born on or after January 1, 2004.

4.2 The regatta will be open to national and international sailors. Number of entries may be limited.

## 5. ENTRIES & ENTRY FEE

5.1 Entries for competitors shall be done online at the event website [lanzarote.dinghycoach.com](http://lanzarote.dinghycoach.com)

Online registrations is available from June 1st, 2018.

5.2 Entries including payment must be received no later than October 15th, 2018.

5.3 Competitors shall provide a signed and completed Parental / Legal Guardian consent form at registration.

5.4 The regatta entry fee will be €75 for the sailors.

5.6 The Organizing Committee has the right to accept entries received after the entry deadline.

## 6. REGISTRATION FOR SAILORS AND COACHES

6.1 Each competitor shall confirm their registration at the Regatta Office on the morning of Friday 2nd November, 2018.

6.2 Coaches shall register at the Regatta Office on the morning of Friday 2nd November, 2018, indicating the sail numbers of the sailors they are coaching.

## 7. REGATTA FORMAT

7.1 The regatta will be sailed in a single fleet

7.2 The regatta will consist of 10 races, with a minimum of 3 races to constitute a series.

## 8. SCHEDULE & PROGRAM

- 8.2 10 races are scheduled with a maximum of 5 races per day.
- 8.3 Every morning there will be a Skippers Meeting to inform the intentions of the RC.
- 8.4 On 3rd November there will be a social event after sailing. On 4th November the Prize Giving will take part as soon as possible after sailing.

## 9. RACING AREA & COURSE

- 9.1 The Sailing Instructions will show the exact location of the racing areas. There will be 2 possible locations, Race Area A in front of Marina Rubicon, Race Area B in front of Papagayo Beach.
- 9.2 The course will be the IODA trapezoid with the finish line at the end of the second windward leg.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will be used.
- 10.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a series.

## 11. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

## 12. SAFETY

- 12.1 Each competitor must wear a personal flotation device (PFD) in accordance with CR 4.2 (a), properly secured at all times, from dock to dock except when temporarily adding or removing clothing. Wet suits, dry suits and inflatable Personal Flotation Devices do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.
- 12.2 All coaches and supporting personnel will be requested to be equipped with and use the life jacket and to carry with them a VHF radio out on the water.

## 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors take part in all races at their own risk. Sailing Events Management S.L., Dinghycoach or MarinaRubicon, or any of their officials or representatives are not responsible, under any circumstances, for any damage, loss or injury either ashore or on the water either to persons or equipment.

13.2 Participation in this event, supporting events and in each race in them is at the sole discretion of the sailor and at his/her own risk. Notice is drawn to RRS 4.

## 14. INSURANCE

Each participant boat must hold third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least 1.000.000 euros per incident. All competitors are required to produce evidence of such insurance at registration, clearly indicating the name of the sailor(s) or the sailing number(s) or the Class registry number(s) of the insured boat(s), including the starting date and ending date of the insurance and the euro amount of the insurance.
