Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority of the regatta is the Orange Bowl Committee and the regatta is hosted by Coral Reef Yacht Club.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.3 The following prescriptions of the US SAILING national authority will apply: 34, 56, 61.4, 67, 76.1, 82 and R.
- 1.4 In the Optimist class RRS 61 will be changed as follows: The red protest flag required in Rule 61.1(a) shall be attached to the lifejacket in a manner that conceals it until displayed. Rule 61.1(a)(2) is deleted. In addition to meeting the requirements of rule 61.1, a boat intending to protest another boat concerning an incident in the racing area that she is involved in or sees shall, at the first reasonable opportunity after she finishes, call the Race Committee's attention to her displayed red flag and inform the Race Committee (RC) of the sail number of the boat she is protesting.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the American English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 Competitors must wear while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing, a properly secured personal floatation device. US competitors must wear USCG approved PFDs. Competitors from outside the U.S. may wear a PFD approved by their nations' certification authority or a USCG approved PFD.
- 1.7 Appendix P will be in effect and may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.8 Class rules regarding qualifying events and championships will not apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to competitors 18 years of age or younger on December 26, 2014 who declare they are members of US Sailing Association, or their national authority, and their respective class association.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to all boats of the Club 420, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and Optimist classes with a maximum number of boats in each fleet as follows: 100 Club 420s, 175 Lasers (Standard, Radial and 4.7 combined) and 300 Optimists (Red, Blue, White and Green combined). You are NOT considered registered until payment has been received. Once a class has reached the capacity limit a waitlist will be generated and posted to the event website. To be entered on the waitlist email cryc@myclubsmail.com, fee is not required at this time. When a spot opens up the next entry on the waitlist for the appropriate class will be notified via email. At the time you are notified you will have 48 hours to complete the registration, including paying the applicable fee. Late fee applies if you entered the waitlist after November 15, 2014 and are accepted into the regatta.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on line or by mailing, together with the required fee, to Coral Reef Yacht Club, 2484 South Bayshore Drive, Coconut Grove, FL 33133 by 1800 hours EST on November 15, 2014. Late entries will be accepted from November 16 to December 15, 2014, and all entry will be closed after December 15, 2014 at 1800 hours EST.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees by 1800 EST on November 15, 2014 are as follows:

Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and Optimist Classes	- \$275.00*
Club 420 Class	- \$380.00*

4.2 Required late fees by 1800 EST on December 15, 2014 are as follows:

Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and Optimist Classes	- \$325.00*
Club 420 Class	- \$450.00* *tax included

A full refund, less a \$50 processing fee, will be granted to those entries cancelled by November 30, 2014 1800 EST.

5 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

Club 420, Laser and Optimist classes may be divided into four or more divisions per fleet.

6 SCHEDULE

7 SUPPORT BOATS

Support and coach boats must register with the organizing authority and provide the names of competitors they support. A fee of \$50.00 per boat is required. In addition, each support and coach boat must carry a VHF radio, monitoring the channel provided for each of their sailors' course at all times while on the water.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

9 BERTHING (without exception)

9.1 Club 420 class will be launched, hauled and stored at Shake-a-Leg Miami.

Laser, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 classes will be launched, hauled and stored at US Sailing Center, Optimist class will be launched, hauled and stored at Coral Reef Yacht Club.

9.2 Each boat is to have its own dolly.

10 VENUE

The location of the regatta will be on Biscayne Bay.

11 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

Club 420 class - Windward/Leeward and Triangle,

Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 classes - ISAF Trapezoid and Windward/Leeward, Optimist Green fleet - Windward/Leeward, Triangle and Modified Olympic, Optimist Red, White and Blue fleets - Modified IODA Trapezoid Course.

12 SCORING

12.1 Twelve (12) races are scheduled. One race for a class or fleet, and one group of races for divisions is required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 The worst score will be excluded with the completion of six (6) races or groups of races. The next-worst score will be excluded with the completion of twelve (12) races or group of races.

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Club 420 – 1 through 10;

Club 420 - first place all female crew;

Laser – 1 through 5;

Laser Radial – 1 through 10;

Laser Radial female – 1 through 5

Laser 4.7 – 1 through 5;

Optimist White - 1 through 10;

Optimist Blue - 1 through 10;

Optimist Red - 1 through 10; Optimist Overall - 1 through 10; Optimist Green - 1 through 10.

14 SAFETY

An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of the sailor.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
