



II. RODOSTO CUP 21-24 July 2016, Tekirdag, Turkey Notice of Race



1. GENERAL

1.1 Tekirdag Sailing Club will host the II.Rodosto Cup and cordially invites all the Sailing Clubs to participate. The event will be held from 21 to 24 July 2016. *Regatta is open Optimist, Laser 4.7 and Laser Radial Class.*

1.2 The venue will be the Tekirdag.

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by:

- a. The “Rules” as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.
- b. The Measurement Instructions.

2.2 National authority prescriptions will not apply.

2.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take in precedence.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all nations.

3.2 Entries shall be made by email to info@tyik.org or tyik@hotmail.com You can find the entry form at the attachment

3.3 *Deadline for the pre-registration is 8 July 2016.*

3.4 Final registrations at the venue shall be made latest, 21 July 2016 at 19.00 by the Race Secretary.

3.5 Sailors and coaches **do not pay** for entry fee.

4. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 09:00 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 20:00 on the day before it will take effect.

5.SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flag pole next to the Race Office. When a signal is displayed over a fleet it applies to that fleet only.

6.SCHEDULE

6.1 The schedule is as follows:

6.2 9 races are scheduled for each class.

7. EVENTS and CLASSES

7.1 The events and classes are as follows:

Boy's One Person Dinghy	Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Optimist
Girl's One Person Dinghy	Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Optimist

9. SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A shall apply.

9.2 To request correction of an alleged error in posted race or series results, a boat shall complete a scoring enquiry form available at the race office.

9.3 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.4 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The Appendix P will apply.

10.2 International jury will be on the water. Decisions of the Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11. SAFETY REGULATIONS

11.1 Check-in and Check-out procedure will be established. Each race day each sailor shall sign personally a list available at the Race Office before going on the race area, and as soon as possible after coming back ashore. The signature of a representative is invalid.

11.2 For each group, the list to check-in will be open from two hours before the first scheduled warning signal up to the starting signal of the concerned group. The list to check-out will be open up to the time limit for lodging protests of the concerned group.

11.3 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

11.4 While afloat, all competitors have to wear life-jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy under all circumstances. Dry suits or wet suits are not adequate personal buoyancy.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

12.1 The host club will help the coaches for support boats. Please contact with organization committee.

12.2 Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

13. TRASH DISPOSAL

13.1 Boats shall not put trash in the water. Trash may be placed aboard support and race committee boats.

14. PRIZES

14.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

- a. Optimist top 10 overall
- b. Optimist top 3 girls
- c. Optimist Junior (born 2005 and after) top 5
- d. Optimist Junior Girls (born 2005 and after) top 3
- e. Laser 4.7 top 3 overall
- f. Laser 4.7 Girls top 3
- g. Laser 4.7 Juniors (born 2001 and after) top 3
- h. Laser Radial top 3 overall
- i. Laser Radial Youth (born 1998 and after) top 3
- j. Laser Radial Girls top 3

15. THE COURSE

15.1 The course will be shown on Notice Board.

16. ADVERTISING

16.1 Boats are required to display advertising chosen and applied by the organizing authority, that is a **50x20cm** sticker.

17. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

17.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

18. CHARTER BOATS
