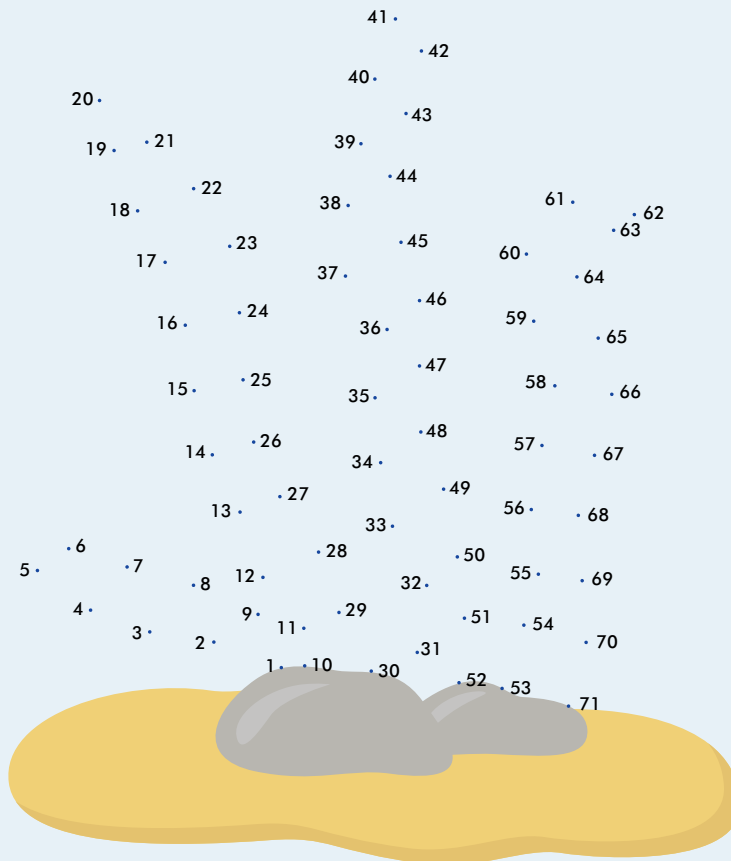

Step 4

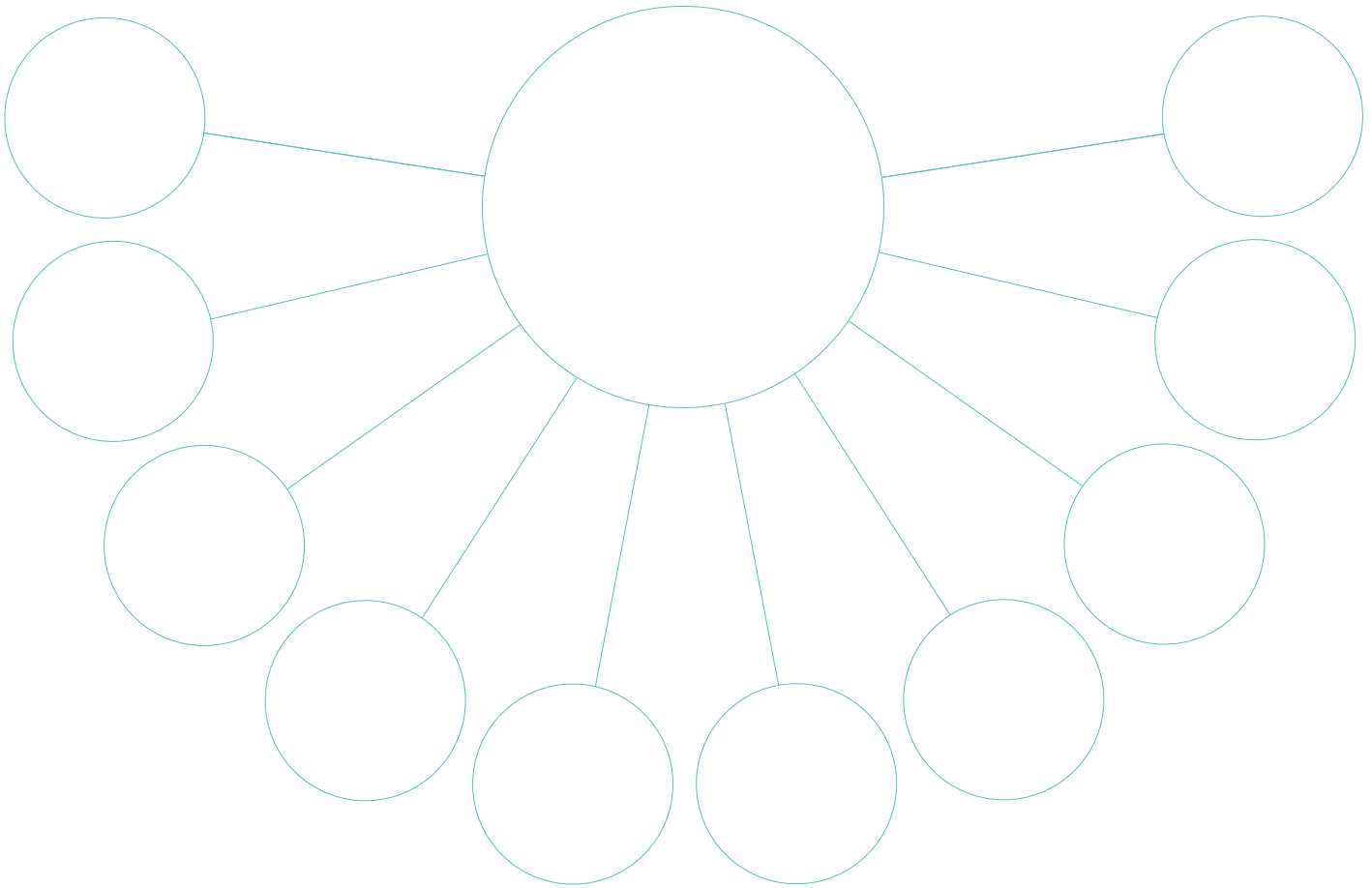

Line 5	Write the name of the cetacean again.


